In addition, implement evidence based and impact centered behavior change communication, identify new and emerging needs for this audience segment and continuously innovating on how best to reach them with sexual and reproductive health and life skills. Establish and maintain stakeholder partnerships in the national and county governments and ensure that program knowledge is generated, collected, updated and disseminated appropriately.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ensure implementation of strategies in accordance with the established program policies, guidelines and procedures.
- Coordinate implementation of Adolescent friendly clinics, Key influence engagement and human capital Indicator in the respective county to facilitate the effective implementation of Binti Shupavu interventions.

- Offer supportive supervision and Technical Assistance to guarantee the adherence and fidelity of the Binti Shupavu touchpoint within Adolescent 360-supported sites.
- Building strong relationships with County and sub county Government Health Management Team (SC/CHMT) and relevant stakeholders to ensure sustainability of A360 intervention and transition to County government.
- Analyze and track dashboards at county level to ensure optimal performance in assigned health area. Collaborate with the MERL and Design team to tracking indicators, quality of completion and on-going activities and support evaluation of impact to inform programmatic decision making at all levels.
- Ensure integration of the Binti Shupavu model into strategic county documents and budget allocation to support program intervention are institutionalized within government workplans.
- Elevate A360 visibility by documenting impactful stories, representing the organization in Adolescent and Youth Sexual and Reproductive Health (AYSRH) forums, conducting sensitization sessions and actively participating in dissemination workshops.
- Supervise, mentor, and give technical guidance to the Youth innovation Champions to improve their supervision and implementation of activities in the assigned counties.
- Collaborate with the County Service Delivery and SBC team to strengthen implementation of A360 intervention at the community and clinics within the County.
- Forecasting county budgets and overseeing the monthly budget management in alignment with the planned field activities.
- · Prepare and submit periodical reports as required capturing best practices and lessons learned
